Policy Criteria for Admission: An Admission Committee Headed by the Director (NTCSP) with Social Welfare Officer, Job Placement Officer, Medical Officer and one Instructor as member for assessment of candidate for seeking admission in the Institute. The Committee also consults other professional staff as and when necessary. The admission eligibility criteria are as under:

- i. A person having a disability of Physically Handicapped, Visually Impaired, Mentally Retarded and Hearing Impaired is eligible for admission.
- ii. Both male and female are entitled for admission, but they should be trainable.
- iii. Applicant must be within the age limit from 15 to 25 years.
- iv. Applicant must be independent in self-help skills such as Toileting, Dressing and eating etc.
- vi. Applicant must have disability certificate.
- vii. Applicant does not have behavioral problems.
